

Results of the Surrey Federation Golden Jubilee and Biennial Exhibition (2010)

The 3 judges scored out of 5 (2 being the lowest mark available to them). Thus the minimum score is 6 and the maximum score is 15. Each entrant could submit 4 images in each class.

The organisers emphasised that you should not be overly disappointed if you did not get acceptances as the standard is of National level.

This year the acceptance cut-off was 12/15 except for DPI which was 11/15.

I have the full list of scores available if the entrants would like them.

The summary below is all the acceptances and certificate winners. I have also included all those images scoring 11 in the print classes as these were near misses.
